The only July 4th events list you'll need:



Downtown Asheville Independence Day Celebration 2018: Pack Square Park 2 p.m., on July 4 . Fireworks will start at 9:30 p.m. <u>Details</u>

Tourists Baseball Game July 4: Watch fireworks + game. Get tickets in advance, since this game will sell out ahead of time.

South Asheville Fireworks: At Lake Julian, fireworks show starts at dark on the July 4, but come early. No pets please due to crowds.

Bryson City: Freedom Fest is an old-fashioned Fourth of July celebration and street festival (10 a.m.-10 p.m.) with a 5K, crafts, food, contests, live music, watermelon eating race and the best fireworks show in the Smokies (10 p.m.).

<u>Lake Junaluska</u>: Parade at 11 a.m., BBQ from noon to 2 p.m., Lake Junaluska Singers concert at 7:30 p.m. Fireworks at 9:30 p.m.

Sylva: Live music and and dancing at 6:30 p.m., <u>fireworks at dark</u> in the picturesque "all-American" small town nestled in the mountains.

Lake Glenville: Watch fireworks from land or the lake on Sunday, July 1, located near Cashiers.

Lake Lure: On July 3, watch fireworks at dusk over the lake from Morse Park (2948 Memorial Hwy, Lake Lure). Watch from the beach, opening at 8 p.m.

Hendersonville: July 4 fireworks at dark, with <u>free live outdoor music</u>, 7-9 p.m. downtown, at 201 South Main (Visitors Center).

Waynesville: The <u>Stars and Stripes parade</u>, 11 a.m., along Main Street with music and sidewalk sales.

Maggie Valley: Backyard Fourth, gates open 6 p.m. and fireworks at dark. Free admission. Alcohol free. Festival Grounds, 3374 Soco Road Maggie Valley.

Cashiers: <u>Fireworks On the Green</u> with festival, food, music and dancing 6:30-10 p.m. Ends with a big fireworks show.

Black Mountain: Family fun and fireworks beginning 7 p.m. on July 4.

Fireworks Hike: View Black Mountain fireworks from Sunset Mountain, presented by the Swannanoa Valley Museum. Meet at 6 p.m. Moderate 45-minute hike to the mountaintop. \$35 for members and \$50 for nonmembers. To register, call 828-669-9566.

Brevard: July 4 ~ <u>5K/10K Firecracker Run</u> 8 a.m. Fine Arts & Craft Festival 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Fireworks 9:30 p.m. at Brevard College.

Brevard Music Center Festival: Patriotic Pops Concert on July 4 at 2 p.m. with favorite marches, Tchaikovsky's 1812 Overture with live cannons.

Weaverville: <u>"Fire on the Lake"</u> at Lake Louise Park with food, vendors and live music 7-10 p.m. and fireworks at 10 p.m.

Cherokee: Pow Wow on June 30-July 1 with authentic Indian dancing, drumming and tribal regalia. Fireworks June 30 at 10 p.m.

Asheville: Country Music at the Double Crown

Hosting New Orleans country singer Esther Rose, Brooklyn country rock outfit Megg Farrell & Friends and L.A. based singer Sabra Guzmán. PBRs are \$1.50 and door money goes to CIMA.

Banner Elk and Beech Mountain: Mile High Fourth

Six-day extravaganza June 29 - July 4. It's the 47th annual, so they must be doin' something right. Parade, a performance of the Wiz, a pig roasting and more!

Morganton: Red, White, and Bluegrass Festival

July 4. Family festival + doughnut-eating contest, music portion of this

festival starts July 5 with three days of bluegrass, featuring 20+ performances.






Obscure Holiday Celebration: Hug Holiday

"It's a patriotic holiday, but the Fourth of July has a dark side." That is an actual sentence posted on Asheville.com. That dark side? FIRE. There are lots of accidental fires and fire related injuries on the Fourth of July. So here are a few pointers:

- 1. Even though they are the O'Doul's of fireworks, the Raisin Bran of July 4th, 19% of firework-related injuries come from sparklers. Remember, the ends are on fire.
- 2. Alcohol and fireworks do not mix. If mixed, beer will cause the firework to go out.
- 3. Only light fireworks outdoors because you don't want everything you own and love to go up in a burning flame.
- 4. Do not set fireworks off of people's heads. I've done this and I can tell you, it's not as dazzling as you'd think. Let my mistakes be your lessons.
- 5. Do not let children set off fireworks. If this needs explanation, maybe you should stick to the hot dogs and pig roasting.
